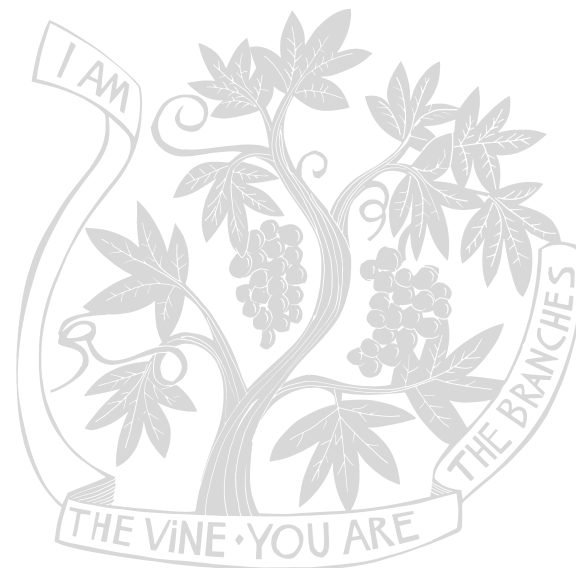
APOSTLES' CREED
